### **Being a Docent is a rewarding experience that requires commitment and dedication. Docents are expected to:**

- Complete six training sessions and learn a tour scripts for the full campus. (Exact training dates to be determined)
- Be comfortable giving a 60-90 minute walking tour without notes, ascending and descending several flights of stairs, and engaging tour groups of all ages.
- Lead a minimum of 10 tours per year and attend an annual safety training program.
- Be available for membership meetings on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month in September, November, February, and April.  
*Luncheon events and field trip opportunities are optional.*
- Pay \$55.00 annual membership dues that support Docent field trips, special meeting programs, and a scholarship for Segerstrom Center's summer camp programs.
