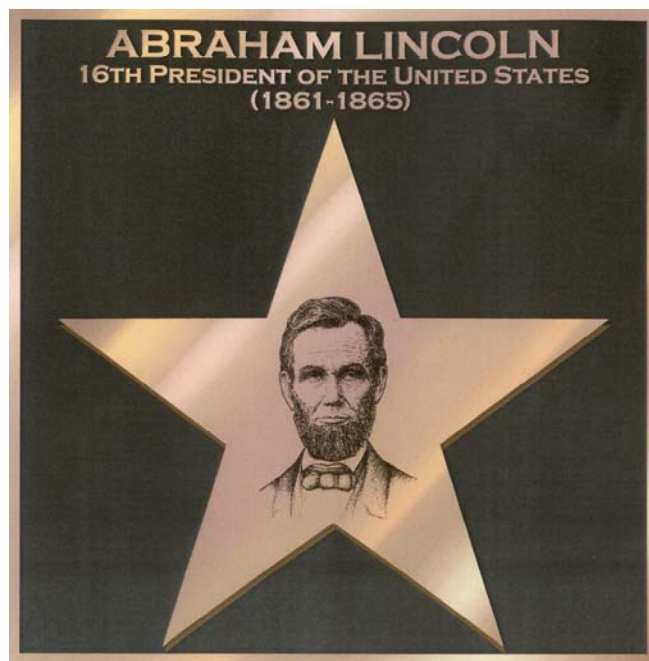
Be Part of the Walk of Greatness

Just as Grauman's Chinese theater's legendary forecourt serves as an oasis to the stars of yesterday and today, the walkway to the Hoogland Center for the Arts main theater, the LRS Theatre, guides the way to the power of the arts for tens of thousands annually.

The roughly one-foot square floor tiles are more than just tiles. They are stepping stones to the future. They are a part of changing the course of humanity — whether it's a child's path in life, a new viewpoint, or an encouraged idea. The arts make a difference in what people become.

By becoming part of the Star Walk program, you become part of history and take a step to make a difference for many. Your financial support helps provide a lasting home for the creative spirit in the Springfield area. And like Grauman's cement handprints and footprints in the forecourt, the Star Walk immortalizes supporters to the Hoogland Center for the Arts as stars.

Solid bronze plates replace the ceramic tiles and remain testimony to your good deed. Stars may recognize individuals (including in memory or in honor of), corporations, foundations, family members, friends, and more. Displayed imagery may include etched images from photographs, logos, and other graphics.



11.75" square by 1/4" thick solid bronze plate embedded in the walkway to facility's main theater (LRS Theatre) guides the way for tens of thousands annually.

This substantial plate weighs an impressive 10 pounds and will last a lifetime.

Stars are \$5,000 each, payable as a one-time gift or as a pledge paid over time.

Permanent gift recognition of all contributions of \$1,000 and above will be placed on the Hoogland Center for the Arts lobby donor wall.
