
## Shout It Out! My Super Show!

## Magic in the Theater

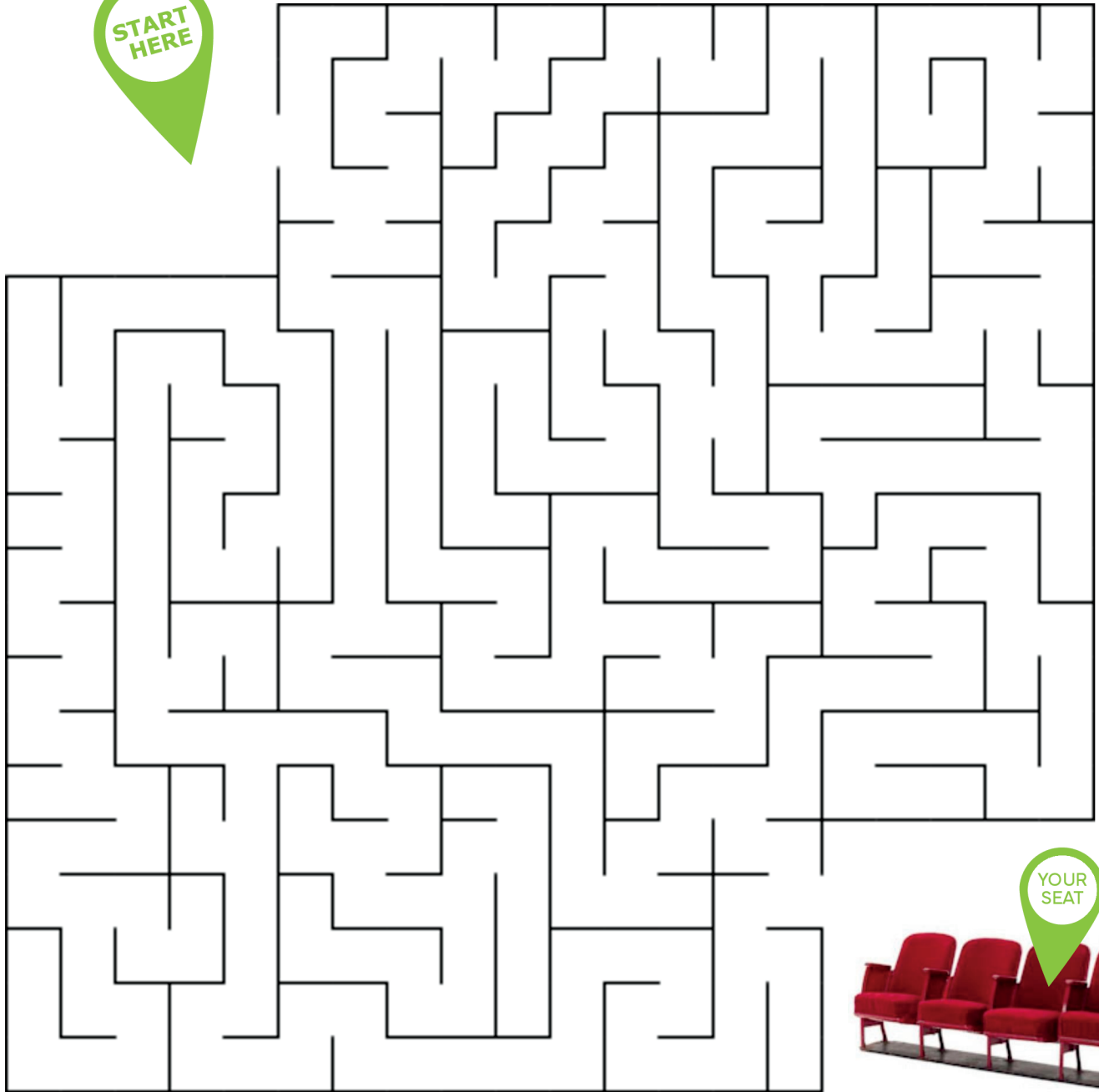
Draw something that made you say "wow!" or seemed magical during your visit to the theater. Maybe it was the huge stage, the shiny lights, or something you noticed outside.
