



TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

PUPPETS & PLAYERS LITTLE THEATRE

In order to facilitate a successful performance, please ensure the following guidelines and items are provided and ready upon the artists' arrival at the school.

Staging: A large outdoor area with flat ground for seating such as a grassy area or parking lot, preferably shady (important in keeping students comfortable and attentive). Puppets and Players is fully self-contained, requiring only electrical power from TWO circuits no further than 100 ft. from the performance area. The wagon theatre is 10' high by 22' long by 8' deep. To reach an outdoor performance area there can be no over-head obstruction lower than 10 ½ feet.

Artist Needs: Water for two artists
One parking space

ARTISTS REQUIRE A TWO-HOUR SET-UP TIME. Upon the artists' arrival, a representative from the school must be on hand to greet and direct them to the performance area.

It is important that assemblies and workshops begin promptly at scheduled times. Arts Teach artists often have engagements immediately following yours at other locations. Performances that begin late due to school delays may result in cancellation. Please have students arrive at least 5 minutes before the program start time to ensure ample time for artist

Teachers set the example for students and strongly affect their behavior at the performance. To encourage maximum learning and program effectiveness we ask that teachers actively participate in the program and refrain from grading papers or doing other work at that time. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

A maximum of 350 students is recommended per assembly. If more than 350, visibility is greatly reduced for students in the back rows.
